- Please do not be late. Only a limited number of people are allowed hence we can't overlap appointments.
- Social distancing seating area away from other clients has been implemented.
- A prescreening questionnaire must be signed on arrival.

- As always, your treatment room is thoroughly sanitised between clients.
- Disposables are only ever used during your treatment and always have been.
